A distinguished practitioner in student affairs, Dr. Pierson has received the Excellence in Practice, Senior Student Affairs Practitioner, and Diamond Honoree Awards from ACPA. Dr. Pierson has served as a leader within the student affairs profession as a member of the ACPA Governing Board, chair for the Mid-Level Management Institute Advisory Committee and Commission for Administrative Leadership, and as the chair of the Senior Student Affairs Officers Task Force.

An alumnus of Michigan State University, Dr. Pierson received his Ph.D in Administration and Higher Education and served as the Director of Student Affairs for the Lyman Briggs Residential College.

The Raines Colloquium honors the significant contributions of Emeritus Professor Max Raines to the department, the college, the university, and the field of student affairs in higher education. A national leader in the field, Dr. Raines was also a critical figure in creating a strong academic and professional foundation for MSU's nationally recognized programs in student affairs, adult education, and higher education.
