- University Degree in any field of study (Math, Science, English preferred for secondary)
- Teaching Experience not required
- Must complete the International Teacher's Training Institute certification (must start once contract is signed, complete 3 modules befores arrival)
- Love for Africa and Africans worldwide
- Ability to cope with physical and cultural challenges
- Plan to pursue Master's, Ph.D., Law school, or start their own business after tenure in Africa

Virtual Teacher Program

Candidates who do not wish to leave the United States can volunteer as Virtual Teachers. They will teach online from the comfort of their home. They will be required to teach for at least 10 hours per week and may receive a stipend of up to 150 000 FCFA.

Some volunteers may qualify for the Federal Student Aid Public Service Loan Forgiveness (PSLF) Program. This program grants debt relief to candidates who work for a non-profit profit organization.
